NHS 111

Call **111** when you need medical help fast but it is not a 999 emergency. NHS 111 is a fast and easy way to get the right help and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Calls are free from landlines and mobile phones. Fully trained advisors will help you get the right medical attention when you urgently need it and can put you through to healthcare professionals.

Call **111** if you need GP out-of-hours services, urgent care or if you need information about a health issue.

NHS Digital 111 Online helps people get urgent care via the 111 online website. People can get medical help or advice at **<https://111.nhs.uk>** using a smartphone, laptop or other digital device.

Pharmacy

Your local pharmacist can give you friendly, expert advice about over-the-counter medicines that can help with lots of common conditions such as diarrhoea, a runny nose, a painful cough or a headache, without the need for an appointment. As well as dispensing prescriptions, pharmacists provide a range of services related to specific health issues and can advise on minor ailments such as colds, skin conditions and allergies. GP services

If you have an illness or injury that will not go away, it is best to visit your GP. You will have to make an appointment to get the treatment you need, but this way you will help reduce the demand on emergency services.

Evening, weekend and bank holiday GP appointments

If you are registered with a GP practice in Barnet, you can access an appointment with a GP or other healthcare professional, on weekday evenings, weekends and bank holidays.

These extended hours appointments are available from 6.30pm to 9.00pm on weekdays and 8.00am to 9.00pm on weekends and bank holidays.

You can book one of these appointments by calling the service directly on **020 3948 6809** (between 6.30pm and 9.00pm) or by contacting your own GP practice during normal practice hours and asking for a "hub" appointment.

The appointment may not be at your usual GP practice, but at another practice within Barnet.



Walk-in centres

Walk-in centres provide medical treatment and advice for patients with injuries which are urgent but do not need a visit to A&E.

They can also be used when you cannot wait for an appointment with your GP. You do not need to book an appointment, just turn up and you will be seen by a doctor or nurse.

In an emergency, call your own dentist for an appointment. If they are closed, call 111 for out-of-hours dental help or advice. Your call will be assessed and if necessary you will be referred to a dental treatment centre. Calls to 111 are free from landlines and mobile phones. Dental assessment operating hours are Monday to Friday, 6pm - 8am and 24 hours on weekends and bank holidays.
